



Course Assessment

A minimum attendance of 85% of the teaching sessions is required

- There are formative and summative assessments at the end of each module. Assessment methods may include essays, presentations, recorded transcripts, case study and observed clinical skills practice. You will also be assessed by your peer group on the course.
- To ensure fairness and consistency, all marking is cross marked, and a sample will be reviewed by an external examiner. You will receive feedback on all formal assessments to support your learning.
- Your placement and clinical supervisor will also submit a report.
- Students are assessed each year and given specific recommendations on areas they need to work on and whether they are ready to progress to the next year. Students can be asked to repeat modules or take time out of training.
